need, I know he has. — When the world goes wrong



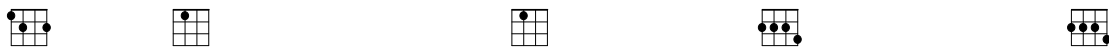

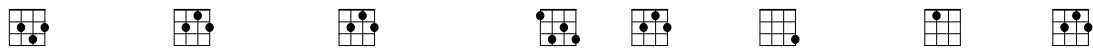
