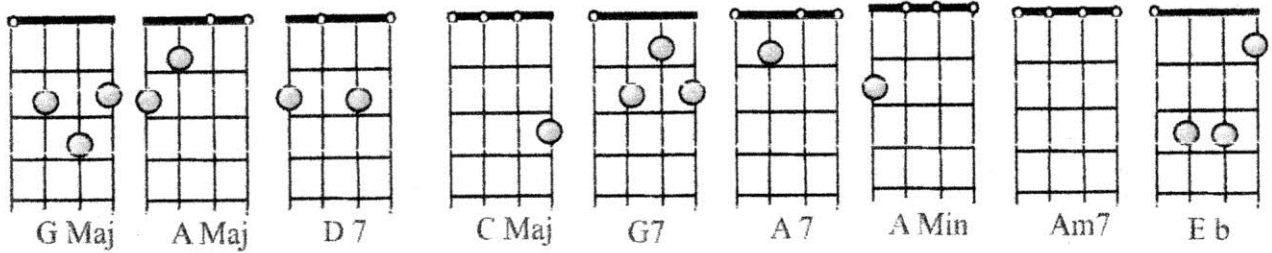


# Chattanooga Choo Choo

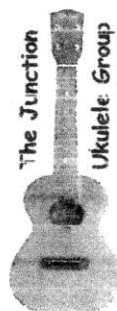
